### **Dryden Deer Ad-Hoc Committee (Several Public Appointees)**

(Term of appointment approximately two (2) months and two (2) to four (4) meetings)

The Committee, under the direction of the CAO, shall have the following goals:

1. Review all current information such as by-laws, input from previous public meetings, new research and options.
2. Receive input from the MNR, Dryden Police Service and local resident concerns.
3. Benchmark and review what other regional municipalities are doing.
4. Identify potential barriers for execution of options.
5. Recommend any by-law changes.
6. Make a recommendation to Council at the October 2017 Council Meeting.

### **Dryden Police Costing Steering Committee (1 Public Appointee)**

(Term of appointment – end of the term of this Council November 2018 and will be subject to reappointment by next Council after 2018 Municipal Election)

The Committee will, under the leadership of the CAO, establish its Terms of Reference for Council approval including roles, responsibilities, accountability and reporting requirements to facilitate the police costing process through to evaluation of proposals and a recommendation to Council. This committee appointment may require travel for outreach to other communities to understand policing models.

The membership of this committee includes three (3) members of Council, a Dryden Police Services Board representative, the CAO, the Treasurer, the Police Chief and a member of the public.
